REGENERATIVE AGROFORESTRY, GUATEMALA

Your support is helping transform degraded farms into thriving, forested landscapes that protect both land and sea. By transitioning slash-and-burn monocultures into regenerative agroforestry systems, this project stabilizes soils, restores biodiversity, and reduces chemical runoff—safeguarding rivers that flow to the Belize Barrier Reef.

Beyond environmental impact, your contribution strengthens local communities: Indigenous families and youth teams gain skills, income, and leadership opportunities while planting fruit and legume trees that provide food, habitat, and carbon storage. From mountain slopes to coral shallows, your support creates a living connection between healthy forests and resilient oceans, proving that when people heal the land, nature thrives.

MORNINGTON PENINSULA, AUSTRALIA

Thanks to the dedication of generous donors and local communities, restoration efforts are helping rebuild a vital wildlife corridor on Victoria's Mornington Peninsula. Native trees and shrubs are re-establishing canopy cover, connecting fragmented habitats, and providing safe passage for koalas, birds, and other wildlife. These plantings also strengthen wetlands and grasslands, supporting frogs, kangaroos, and powerful owls, while fostering the overall ecological health of this biodiverse landscape.

By restoring connectivity across urbanizing areas, the project helps wildlife move, feed, and breed more safely, while encouraging community stewardship of local ecosystems. Early signs of success—returning frogs, kangaroos, and increasing koala sightings—demonstrate the impact of collaborative restoration. Together, this work is ensuring that the Mornington Peninsula's forests and wildlife can thrive now and for generations to come.
